Upon intimation of acceptance of the abstract, the full paper shall have to be submitted in not more than 10 pages (including graphs, charts etc. if any).

Other guidelines for abstract and Full Paper Submission

The papers are to be typed in English in word file in Times New Roman font at 12 pts font size with single line spacing format. Provide the complete information on the author(s) with email id and the telephone/mobile numbers. Abstract/full Papers should be sent only as MS Word attachment to aicp18conference@skasc.ac.in. Reference should be provided in the APA format.

- Papers will be reviewed by the Peer review committee.
- Abstract along with the research papers will be accepted with conference registration fee which will be non - refundable.
