- Eco Initiative SKASC bagged All India 4<sup>th</sup> place in Swachtha Ranking to spread awareness on the importance of cleanliness in their surroundings and regular societal activities are conducted by students as part of their curriculum to fulfill our Prime Minister Dream of clean India.
- Best Local Chapter in NPTEL More than 5000 students and 300 faculty members have enrolled for NPTEL online courses so far. As recognition SKASC has been awarded as Best Local Chapter by NPTEL in terms of enrollment and percentage of passes.
- Placement offer from Core Companies SKASC conducts pre-placement training sessions to equip students with relevant skills in their respective fields. About 90 - 95% aspiring students were placed in reputed companies every year.
