1. General Discussions on curriculum

- i) 7623 students are studying during the academic year 2018-19.
- ii) 1907 placement offers were received from reputed Multinational companies during the academic year 2018-2019.
- iii) UG Programmes: B.Sc. (Psychology), B.Com. (Business Analytics), B.A. (Tourism and Travel Management), M.A. (Public Administration) and B.Com. (Banking and Insurance) Additional Section is introduced in this academic year 2018-19.
- iv) Our College has been ranked 64thin College Category by NIRF (National Institute Ranking Framework).
- v) Our College has been re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade and CGPA of 3.26 on 4 point scale.
- vi) Our College has been ranked 4th in the cleanest Higher Educational Institutions in the Country by Swachh Campus Ranking 2018 of Higher Educational Institutions.
- vii) India today has ranked the College in National Level under following categories.
 - #58th Position among Commerce Colleges in National Level.
 - #39th Position in BCA in National Level.
